HONOR FLIGHT SOUTH FLORIDA

Highlights of the General Meeting - February 1st, 2017

MOMENT OF SILENCE: The meeting opened with a moment of silence for Navy Seal William Ryan Owens, who was killed in Yemen this week. He is the first American to die in combat since the change in administrations.

ONE BIG CHANGE ON FLIGHT DATES: There is one major change in the 2017 flight schedule. The flight with Vietnam veterans serving as Elite Guardians has been moved to Sept. 9.

April 8 -- Fort Lauderdale to Baltimore-Washington International.

May 20 -- Miami to Reagan National.

Sept. 9 -- Fort Lauderdale to Reagan National with Vietnam veterans serving as Elite Guardians.

Oct. 28 -- Miami to Washington Dulles -- Historic Airbus 380 flight with 200 World War II veterans.

SPECIAL VIRTUAL HONOR FLIGHT: Honor Flight will be hosting a Virtual Flight 1-4 p.m., Saturday, Feb. 11 at the Miami VA Hospital. There will be 55-60 wheelchair-bound veterans, representing World War II, Korea, Vietnam and Desert Storm who reside at the hospital. Bev Engler and Elaine Martin are planning the event with mail call and Jim Naskrent's Honor Flight movie. Melissa Sauer and the Young Marines will be participating. AWARD FOR VOLUNTEER RECRUITING MOST WORLD WAR II VETERANS: With four flights planned, including the October flight with 200 World War II veterans, Chairman Rick Asper said the volunteer who recruits the most WWII veterans will receive a staff seat on the mega-flight. Rick said there will be final details at the next meeting. ... We have received a list of phone numbers of thousands of residents who were born during the years that could place them in the World War II era. We will need volunteers to start making calls. ...
